(2) **Son** incarnate

In the Gospels, He Is described as compassionate, selfless, diligent, and obedient.

The Spirit, who is the ultimate expression of the

Triune God, was not yet in John 7:39, because at that time Jesus had not yet been glorified. As the embodiment of God, He had to pass through specific stages to accomplish God's desire. After Jesus's incarnation, human living crucifixion, death and resurrection, everything was finished. The Triune God had to pass through these different stages to become the life-giving Spirit.

(4) Crucifixion

(10) Church built of Believers

The purpose of God's salvation is to have Christ reproduced in millions of saints that they may become the members of His Body, not separate and complete individual units but parts of a living, functioning, coordinated, corporate whole.

This diagram gives an overview of God's plan and purpose. Because of His great love for us, God desires to have an intimate, relationship with mankind. Yet as the Father, he was unapproachable and distant from man. To become nearer to man, in time the Father became the Son. Yet God wanted an even closer union with His people. For this he became the Spirit, so that anyone, anywhere and in any age can receive the Spirit, one by one. Of those who receive the Spirit, he builds them together into the universal church. God's plan for the building of the church began in eternity past, and is being fulfilled today as the church matures in the life of Christ.
